INTRODUCTION

"Find out if the school needs and wants to promote GREEN Education"

<u>Green Hero Model for engaging the schools and educational bodies</u> is an important instrument that aims to identify potential entities to take part in the project and increase the number of schools who accept to be involved in the project and to participate in the School GREEN Education Program.

Encourage schools to adopt comprehensive environmental protection promotion programs.

DESCRIPTION

"Become A GREEN Hero!"

This **GREEN Hero Project Model** provide the local instruments used at national level by each partner for encouraging schools to adopt comprehensive environmental awareness programs, for **develop an effective model for engaging schools and educational bodies "Become A GREEN Hero!"** and to find elements involved in initiating, educating and motivating schools to undertake environmental awareness activities tailored to their local needs.

The partners from UK will use a specific involvement of the schools.

Local training needs will be identified **analyzing the curriculum or applying a questionnaire** around key subjects such as waste, water and energy –online or face-to-face- (School: "Why do we need the Green Hero project?" – "Because the curriculum is intended for the acquisition and extension of sustainable knowledge...") and in **recording** already established school action systematized in waste, water and energy.





1. RATIONALE

<u>"Easy to learn GREEN"</u>

Encouraging schools to adopt comprehensive environmental awareness programs is often difficult given the current education climate of devolved decision making, crowded curriculum, an increasing number of curriculum areas vying for status and time on the school's agenda and disturbances.

The United Nations has designated the period 2005 to 2014 as the decade of "Education for Sustainable Development". The objective is to integrate the concept of sustainable development in education processes around the world.

Environmental education is an integral aspect of this concept. It is a process of action-oriented, political learning.

2. <u>AIM</u>

To find elements involved in initiating, educating and motivating schools to undertake environmental awareness activities tailored to their local needs.

3. **STRATEGY**

"Motivate the school to allocate resources to Sustainable Development through GREEN/Environmental

Education"

Fundamentally, commitment of money, time and personnel by the school and its local community, coupled with good utility knowledge about environmental protection promotion and community environmental protection resources are essential elements in successful school-based promotion.

The **GREEN Hero Project Model** incorporates both:

- the concept of **School GREEN Education' promotion** and
- the concept of a <u>GREEN Education promoting schools.</u>

School students participating in the project will increase the sustainability knowhow of school.

The GREEN Hero project promotes the new concepts as:





- *GREEN Education
- *GREEN Team
- *GREEN Crystals

The GREEN Heroes project gives participants:

- * access to e-learning platform for awareness of issues facing the environment,
- *e-learning courses,
- *European contacts with the students of the same age

4. METHODOLOGY

"Use the previous experiences"

The GREEN Hero Project Model incorporates the **GREEN Education PROMOTING SCHOOLS** concept within the "STRATEGIES AND SUPPORT" and the "SCHOOL COMMUNITY" sections in particular, but also incorporates "SCHOOL GREEN Education' PROMOTION" activity (i.e. School GREEN Education' promotion) in the "BENEFITS" section; the Model include Motivating Procedure and Instruments.

A school could potentially become interested in developing GREEN Education through any one of the "INDIVIDUAL MILESTONES", "STRATEGIES OR SUPPORTS" mentioned in the model.

Each of these factors, and others, could put GREEN Education on the school agenda.





Ideally, once this initial interest is generated, school staff and parents will develop a sophisticated understanding of school environmental awareness, which would involve systematically addressing other key components of the model, to ensure a comprehensive approach.

Encourage parents to provide input as decision makers, workers for the school GREEN Education Program; make it clear that influences on the development of children's Environment protection behaviors' are multi-factorial and complex.

Initiate and develop Green promotion activities to Motivate "in situ" (Supports and strategies): provide resources and expertise to the schools, which will be used in a manner decided by the whole school community (including teachers, parents and students) and thus tailored to the needs of individual school communities.

Encouraging schools to adopt Environmental Education promotion as part of their organizational practice: various models of comprehensive school environmental protection can be developed which incorporate fundamental and mutually supportive factors that influence children's environmental protection behaviors' including.



	Impacts on student's behaviors.
	*Schools have an important contribution to make in influencing the development of children's behaviors' on environmental protection
	*Schools have access to large numbers of children for extended periods.
	*This access puts schools in an ideal position from which to initiate interaction between key influences on children's environmental behaviors', to create supportive environments and reinforce messages from outside the school setting
	The correct choices and behavior patterns adopted during childhood are often maintained into and throughout adulthood.
	Schools accord high priority to providing teachers and parents theoretical and practical <u>training</u> so that they can change attitudes to waste and consumer habits.
	Possibility for students and teachers to post articles in the <u>Newsletter/textbook</u> of the project and on the e-learning Platform (as GREEN Hero 'Guide, for ex.).
